**Dates:** Sunday, 15th March 2026 – Long Course (50m Pool)

**Age Groups:** 10–11, 12–13, 14–15, 16 & Over (ages 16–18) (Age as at 2026: **TAA Rules**)

## Events

**Entry Fee:** Each swimmer will receive a souvenir.

- **Saturday only:** 1,000 Baht per swimmer
- **Sunday only:** 1,200 Baht per swimmer
- **Both days:** 2,200 Baht total

#### **Saturday Events:**

- Swimmers may enter all individual events in their age group.
- Each swimmer may participate in a maximum of one (1) relay.
- Mixed relays must include two (2) boys and two (2) girls.

#### **Sunday Events:**

- Swimmers may enter up to six (6) individual events and two (2) relays.
- Each school may enter a maximum of two (2) relay teams per event.

#### **Entry Deadline:**

- All entries must be submitted by **Monday, 2nd March 2026, at 5:00 PM.**
- Entries must be submitted via a TM entry file and accompanied by an entries report.

#### **Important Notes:**

- No underage swimmers will be accepted.
- No changes to event entries will be allowed on the meet day.
- **NT (No Time) entries will not be accepted.**
- Withdrawals must be made by **Thursday, 5th March 2026, at 5:00 PM.** After this deadline, all entries will be charged, regardless of participation.

#### **Rules and Regulations:**

- The meet will be conducted as a Timed Finals event.
- Electronic timing systems will be used throughout the meet.

**Coaches Meeting:** Will be at 7.35 am in the PE Classroom (2nd floor)

#### **Meet Information:**

- This meet **on Sunday** will be Verified *by the Thailand Aquatics Association*.
- Records from this meet will be collected into the TAA database.
- The morning session will start at 8:00 am.
- Warm-up will be available from 6:30 am - 7:30 am
- FINA rules will apply throughout the meet on Sunday.
- Protests and scratches can be submitted by a team coach. No parental queries will be entertained.
- There will be a 30 minutes time limit for protests following the posting of official results as per FINA rules.
- The Meet Director reserves the right to change the meet at any time.

#### **Protests & Scratches:**

- Only team coaches may submit protests or scratches. Parental queries will not be accepted.
- As per FINA regulations, protests must be submitted within 30 minutes of the official results being posted.
- The Meet Director reserves the right to modify the meet program or schedule at any time.

**Marshalling:**

- Coaches and swimmers are responsible for monitoring race announcements and ensuring timely arrival at the marshalling area.
- Swimmers' names will not be called individually. No additional announcements will be made for missing swimmers or relays.
- Only swimmers and coaches are permitted in the marshalling area.
- Each school is expected to provide at least one coach to assist with marshalling duties.

**Spectators:**

- All adults must display a valid school ID badge.
- Guests without a badge should check in at the reception desk for assistance.

**Team Resting Area:**

Each team will be assigned a designated rest area within the Sports Hall. All teams must be supervised by a staff member from their respective school at all times.

**Lunch Arrangements:**

Food vendors will be available on-site; however, lunch will not be provided for the athletes. Please ensure that they bring a packed lunch, snacks, and a refillable water bottle.

- Individual Events 1st – 12th (20, 18, 16, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 3, 2, 1)
- Relay Events 1st – 12th (40, 36, 32, 28, 24, 20, 16, 12, 8, 6, 4, 2)

### **Awards:**

- Overall and age group trophies will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place at the end of the meet.
- Medals will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each event. Coaches have to collect the medals at the medal table.
- 9&U swimmers that finish 1st in their heat will get a "Heat winner" souvenir.
- Relay points are doubled with only the fastest team scoring from each school will be eligible to score points.
